Strong organisation skills and leadership skills are necessary for this role, and this must be evidenced.

As a member of the Commission, you will be expected to implement the strategic agenda of the organisation and attend regular meetings with colleagues, Executive Committee, Athletes & Coaches Commission and other relevant groups.

You are expected to be an ambassador for the WUKF.

## The Commission

- 7 WUKF Referees
- 1 Member of the WUKF Executive Committee Mr Joe Mirza

# Please note:

- The Commission will stand down every 4 years with reselection completed by an application process. All members will be subject to an annual appraisal by the WUKF Executive Committee.
- If a member leaves the Commission within the term, the vacancy will be advertised with a new member being appointed by the Executive Committee.
- The Referee Commission & Executive Committee can invite any relevant party of attend meetings.

### **Application Process**

There is a four-stage application process outlined below:

- Applicants must receive approval from their National Federations to apply.
- A covering letter and Karate CV (including relevant external experience) must be sent to roy.okane@wukf.org by no later than 17:00 BST on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September. In the covering letter, please include a brief description of why you want to apply (covering letter minimum of 250 words).
- Applications will be scrutinised with selected applicants being invited for an online interview with members of the Executive Committee.
- Successful applicants ratified by the Executive Committee and notified.
