#### 3. Championship Venue and Official Hotel

The Boardwalk Hotel, International Convention Centre, Casino and Entertainment World in Gqeberha offers premier luxury hotel accommodation only a few minutes away from the Blue Flag awarded Hobie Beach. Not only popular for its premier luxury hotel, The Boardwalk is also a unique entertainment, casino, dining and conference venue. Adjacent to the hotel is the newly upgraded and refurbished Boardwalk Mall, which provides shoppers with a thrilling retail experience, numerous restaurants, coffee shops as well as a cinema complex.

Overlooking the Indian Ocean, this sprawling casino hotel is 5km from both the Humewood Golf Club and the Chief Dawid Stuurman International Airport. Each of the luxuriously appointed sea-facing hotel rooms at The Boardwalk enjoy uninterrupted ocean views, and offer sumptuous premier luxury comfort for guests visiting South Africa's Friendly City. The Boardwalk Hotel is ideally positioned along the Golden Mile where a host of family-friendly and outdoor activities are available. #### 4. Eastern Cape Province and Surrounds

The Boardwalk Hotel provides the perfect base from which to explore the Eastern Cape Province. Near to the hotel, is a selection of some of South Africa's most beautiful, pristine, and iconic beaches. Gqeberha also has a rich history dating back to the 1800's with several landmarks, museums, and places of interest within easy reach of the hotel.

The Eastern Cape is home to the Big Five and offers some of the best game viewing opportunities in South Africa. World class game lodges and parks can be found within 60 to 90 minutes' drive of the city. These include the internationally acclaimed Addo National Park, Amakhala, Pumba, Sibuya, Kariega and Shamwari Game Reserves. The area is also malaria free.

Gqeberha also offers an amazing shopping experience with the newly refurbished Boardwalk Mall (adjacent to the Hotel), Walmer Park Shopping Centre and Baywest Mall rating among the top shopping destinations in the city.

Slightly further afield is Jeffrey's Bay - this legendary surfers' paradise is considered to have one of the very best righthand point breaks in the world.

Inland, the frontier towns of Bathurst and Makhanda (previously Grahamstown) are situated within 90 minutes' drive of the hotel. Both towns are steeped in history and charm harking back to the 1800's. The picturesque coastal resort towns of Kenton on Sea and Port Alfred lie to the East of Gqeberha.

Opportunities to participate in adventure sports and activities abound, including bungee jumping at Bloukrans Bridge (one of the highest jumps in the world), scuba diving, mountain biking, hiking, and others.

Gqeberha is considered the gateway to the spectacularly scenic Garden Route (N2), which offers an exquisitely beautiful coastal road trip to Cape Town via Storms River, Plettenberg Bay, Knysna, Sedgefield and Wilderness.

As an inland alternative to Cape Town, Route 62 is the longest wine route in the world and passes through the Klein Karoo which features several historic South African towns.









For those visitors who would prefer to just relax and focus on the weekend's karate activities, the good news is that once you arrive at The Boardwalk Hotel, there is no further need to travel.

#### 5. Closing Date for Entries, Corrections, and payments

**Kihapp** The Kihapp Online Tournament Management System will be used to register all athletes, coaches, and referees. A link and instructions will follow in November 2024. It is recommended for each federation to appoint one team manager to register their federation's athletes for the Championship. The team manager may share the link with his/her dojo-heads. Entry forms for officials attending the cocktail evening (open to referees, jury table judges, coaches, athletes, and partners), the federation heads' dinner as well as order forms for WUKF blazer badges, ties, championship t-shirts will be available to download from Kihapp as from November 2024. Federation Heads are requested to ensure that this invitation along with the relevant entry forms are timeously distributed to their affiliates.

Closing date: Saturday,1<sup>st</sup> March. This is the final date for the submission of all entries via Kihapp as well as the return of forms for the cocktail evening, federation heads' dinner and WUKF apparel and merchandise orders. ECSR will invoice each Federation on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of March. The final date for payment will be Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> March. Each Federation is required to make a single payment on behalf of their members. *Regrettably no late entries will be accepted thereafter*.

#### Entry fees for athletes:

First two individual events (individual kata and kumite): ZAR 280 per category.

Third or additional individual events: ZAR 120 per category.

#### Team events:

Team events: ZAR 120 per team member.

#### Entry fees for spectators:

ZAR60 per day: Adults and Children. Children under 5: Free. Payment may be made on arrival either via cash or card (card facilities will be available at the entrance to the venue).

Corrections: Kihapp will reopen from Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> March until Thursday, 6<sup>th</sup> of March for any corrections.

The team manager is responsible for ensuring that all his/her athletes have been placed in the correct categories. Inaccurate information pertaining to weight, age or belt will result in the athlete being disqualified from his/her respective category/categories. Spot weight checks may be conducted at the Championship.

#### 6. Courses for Officials

Referees', judges', coaches', and jury table judges' courses will be conducted by senior referees, coaches, and officials via Zoom. Dates will be communicated to all federation heads in due course. For referees, judges and coaches who can attend, a course will be held in the championship venue on Thursday, the 3<sup>rd</sup> of April at The Boardwalk Hotel. This will be conducted by South Africa's Chief Referee. Time 14:00 to 18:00. Referees and judges must please wear their official attire and coaches a tracksuit.

#### 9. Medical assistance

Trained medical personnel will be on hand to provide medical assistance in the event of injuries.

# 10. Restaurants

There is a restaurant in the Hotel as well as numerous restaurants and fast-food outlets at the Boardwalk Mall which is adjacent to the venue.

## 11. Photography

Professional photographers will be available to capture action and podium shots. These will be available for download, free of charge after the championship

## 12. Rules and Guidelines

The Championship rules will be based on the WUKF rules with amendments. It is the responsibility of the team manager and/or coach to be familiar with the rules and to inform their athletes accordingly. ## 13. Equipment

#### Compulsory equipment for WUKF SA Championships:

- Mitts (Shobu Ippon, Shobu Nihon and Sanbon kumite). Athletes may use bubble mitts (with or without thumb protector) for both Shobu Sanbon and Shobu Ippon kumite (alternatively athletes may use WUKF approved Shobu Ippon mitts).
- Except for Junior, Senior and Veteran elite (black belt) categories, competitors will only be required to have one pair of mitts (red or white).
- Gum shields must be worn for all kumite. May be any colour (preferably clear) except for red.
- Groin protectors for male cadets, juniors, seniors, and veterans.

#### Optional

- Chest protectors (Female Kumite).
- Body protectors (Children Nihon Kumite).
- Helmets (Children Nihon Kumite).

#### **Allowed Equipment**

- Sport glasses and contact lenses at own risk during kata.
- Groin protectors (Nihon Kumite).
- Shin protectors (Sanbon Kumite).
- White shin/instep protectors. May wear red if aka in nihon or sanbon Kumite.

#### Forbidden Equipment:

- Spectacles (glass or hard plastic) for kumite.
- Shin protectors for Ippon kumite.
- Instep and shin protectors for Ippon Kumite
- Blue mitts, instep, and shin protectors.
- WKF labels on all equipment (including karate dogi) must be removed or taped over.

# Provided equipment:

Red and white belts will be provided at each floor.

#### 14. Determining the age of an Athlete

The age of the athlete will be determined by his/her age as on the 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025.

#### **15.** Combining of Categories

A minimum of four athletes must register for a category for it to be considered valid. If the threshold point is not met, athletes will be moved into the next most suitable category. The organisers reserve the right to combine or divide categories according to the athletes' height/weight/belt/age.

#### 16. Medals

Medals will be awarded to the top three individual competitors/teams in each kumite, kata and kobudo category.

#### **17. Provincial and National Colours**

WUKF SA and WUKF in South Africa are currently not authorised to award provincial or national colours to athletes.

#### 18. Coaches

One coach for every 10 athletes per Federation will be allowed. Only coaches who attend the official course/s will be accredited to coach at the Championship. Coaches must wear a tracksuit. A tracksuit top may however be substituted with a golf shirt. Registration is ZAR 100 per coach.

#### 19. Draw Sheets

- The knockout drawsheet system will be implemented for all kumite categories.
- The points system will be used for all kata and kobudo categories.

#### 20. Dress code for referees and judges

The official referees' uniform for the Championship comprises: • A navy-blue blazer bearing two silver buttons • A WUKF badge • A white short sleeve shirt • A red WUKF / continental tie. • Light grey trousers • Black socks covering 2/3rd of the shin. • Black soft sole shoes.

#### 21. Disclaimer/indemnity form

The disclaimer/indemnity form must be correctly completed and returned to the organisers prior to, or on the day of the Championships. The disclaimer/indemnity will be available for download from Kihapp.
