**PAIRS ENTRIES:** £26 per pair

**TEAM EVENTS:** £30 per team





## EVENT INFORMATION:

Entry entry must be completed and submitted by the official Association or Club representative.

Registration will open on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May and deadline for entry form will be Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> May.

Entry will be via Uventex Labs online – this will be a club registration event so please contact [support@wukf.org](mailto:support@wukf.org) if you do not already have a login for your club/federation.

All athletes must be fully insured for this event by their Association and should be aware that all categories will operate under WUKF rules (subject to minor amendments) which can be found here at [www.wukf-karate.org](http://www.wukf-karate.org)

Once entries are closed, a running order and event protocol guide will be issued to all federations in advance of the event.

**KOBUDO:** Held under WUKF Rules

**INCLUSIVE KARATE:** Held under WUKF Rules

Competitors are permitted to enter all Kata/Kumite Categories that their age permits and they may also enter the category above their age group. Seniors may not compete in veterans categories. In Kumite, competitors can enter both Ippon and Sanbon categories in this event only.

When completing the entry online, please ensure you list all Coaches. Only coaches and athletes will be allowed on the competition area. Once entry is confirmed, no refunds will be given.

Spectator tickets can be purchased on the day at the door or in advance via a link to be circulated to those attending.



# OTHER MATTERS:

**Photography Policy** - Official photographers will be operating for the duration of the event. If individuals do not wish to be featured on official photography, then the organisers must be notified by the Association representative.

**Appeals** - If a problem arises at the competition, only the Head Coach can approach the Chief Referee. If the Head Coach wishes to make a formal protest then they must do so by completing the relevant form and lodging a £50 fee with the top table. An appeals jury of the highest level referees will be selected to review. If the protest is upheld, then the protest fee will be returned. If it is not upheld, then the protest fee will go towards all admin fees for the protest.
